Musical Theater (Drama) gives children the experience of working intensively in group rehearsals and the challenge of performing before family, peers and the community. It also facilitates the development of social and personal skills, as well as artistic learning in the fields of dance, drama and music.

Will my child experience long-term benefits from a musical performance class?

Cognitive Learning—creative thinking abilities, such as originality and elaboration, and the ability to synthesize and represent knowledge from multiple domains and learning disciplines

Personal Learning—positive risk-taking, self-confidence, task persistence, motivation, self-discipline and improved social behavior

Social Learning—positive impact on children's relationships with others, including teachers and peers

Arts Learning—music, character development, dramatic expression, dance (kinesthetic awareness, concentration, and focus in performing movement skills)

Academic Learning—language skills (speaking, listening, vocabulary, diction, meaning and interpretation of a text, narrative, and character development)

Grades 3-8 are invited to participate in the class. Musical Theater will be held on **Tuesdays** (at the specified times on the front of the brochure) in Dominican Hall at Holy Rosary School. There is a **Registration Fee of \$125.00 (\$95 for Returning Students who were in "Grease")**. The Registration Fee will cover , licensing, theater rental deposit, program printing, technical assistants, libretto books, CD's, props, and backdrop paint and materials. Each student /parent is responsible for their /their child's costumes (The director will assist and direct). **The Registration Fee secures your child's place in this program.** The class roster is filled on a **"First-Come, First-Served"**, basis. There are 36 spots available!

The **tuition for March-June**, will be **\$70/month**. You must **register by Monday, February 27, 2012**. The **\$125/\$95 for Returning "Grease" Students, Registration Fee is due at the time of Registration.**
